EVALUATION CRITERIA (IWE):

For MCQ: Each question carries equal marks. The Max mark for MCQ will be 1 and minimum mark will be 0 (zero)

With each question, 4 answering options have been given: a), b), c) and d). There may be more than ONE correct answer for a question. One has to choose all the right options to get full marks.

Each question carries total 1 mark, distributed proportionately among the correct answer option(s) as shown below:

Number of correct answers per question	Scoring Value in % per each correct answer
4 correct options	25%
3 correct options	33.33%
2 correct options	50%
1 correct option	100%

There will be proportionate negative marking for selecting a wrong answer. However, NO NEGATIVE marks will be carried over from one question to another question.

For Descriptive type: Out of 14 question you will have to write 10 questions. Each question carries a total of 6 marks.

Similar for all the modules. All 3 criteria's to be fulfilled to pass each module.

For Descriptive type: Out of 12 question you will have to write 9 questions. Each question carries a total of 6 marks.
